Calling All Artists!

Are you an artist waiting to be discovered? Perhaps you are a seasoned artist looking to display your talent? Whether you are an established artist or a novice looking for exposure, we are seeking exhibitors of all levels to display their creations at Church of the Atonement's Annual Arts Festival. The week-long festival will begin on Wednesday, May 17th and will run through Wednesday, May 24th. The highlight of the festival will be a Gala Art Show Opening with a wine and cheese reception on May 17th from 6pm to 8pm. All works of art will be displayed in Atonement's Fellowship Hall for the duration of the festival.

The Gala Opening will be followed by a series of evening offerings, including a cabaret with a variety of performers, an open mic poetry night, and a classical concert to close out the week. All events are open to the public. Information about concert and cabaret tickets and reservations can be found on Atonement's website; all other events are free. All proceeds support the Church's Arts and Music fund.

Artists may display up to three works. All art mediums are accepted including ceramics, crafts, digital artwork, drawings, prints, engravings, environmental, fashion, glass, jewelry, metalwork, needlework, paintings, photography, sculpture, textiles, and woodwork. There are no age restrictions, no booth fees and exhibitors are not required to be present during the festival.

Each exhibitor must submit an entry form with their work containing their contact information, a brief description of the artwork, and the suggested sale price, if the piece is for sale. The chairpersons of the festival will be available to conduct sales in the absence of the artist. A free-will offering is gratefully received in the event of a sale (5% to 10% of the sale price is suggested).

Works of art may be dropped off at the church office on Tuesday - Friday, May 2-5 and May 9-12 from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm, or on Saturday, May 6th from 10:30am to 12:30pm. Please enter through the red doors located at the center of the building between the church and the chapel. Entry forms are available in the church office as well as on Atonement's website at www.atonement-tenafly.org.

May 17 - Opening of the Community Art Exhibit, "Meet the Artists" Wine & Cheese 6:00-8:00 pm – This event is free and open to all.

May 19 – Cabaret Night featuring kids' improv group, Coffee and Dessert. 7:30 – 9:00 Seating is limited: Reservations are required. Tickets: \$10/person; no charge for children 15 and under. Contact the church for reservations and tickets.

May 21 - Arts & Music Sunday features soloists performing in the 10 am service, followed by Coffee Hour in the Art Exhibit, and an afternoon Newcomers' Reception at a parishioner's home. This event is free and open to all.

May 23 – Open Mic Poetry Night, Wine & Cheese Reception. This event is free and open to all.

May 24 – Light Classical Concert – Northwest Winds perform works by Wine & Cheese reception Tickets: \$20/person; \$5 for students. Tickets can be purchased through the Church office or at the door.
